

Qualifications for election as Member of Board: [Rule 19J(5) (c) of MSCS Rules, 2002](a) To be nominated as a candidate for election to fill a seat on the Board, the candidate must have the following qualifications: 1. He should comply with the conditions mentioned in clause No. 4 and sub section. 2. He should hold at least 25000/- of shares having 2500 units (corrections initiated*) of Rs. 100/- each. 3. He should have at least 1,00,000/- of deposit with the society prior to six months before the election declared. 4. He/she should not have any criminal record.

(b) As per Section 19-J(5), no person shall be nominated as a candidate for election to fill a seat on the Board if he, (i) Is ineligible to vote; (ii) Is not qualified or is disqualified to be the member of a Multi-State Cooperative Society or a member of a Board under the provision of the MSCS Act, 2002 and the MSCS Rules, 2002; and (iii) Does not possess the necessary qualifications specified above for election as member of the Board.
